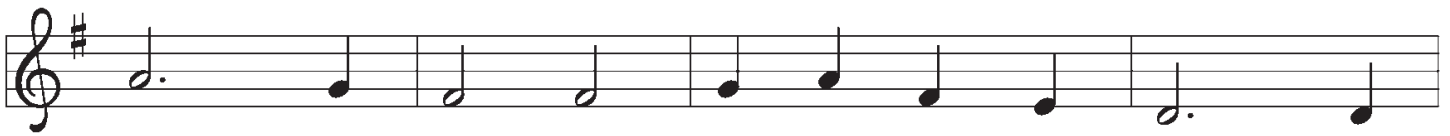

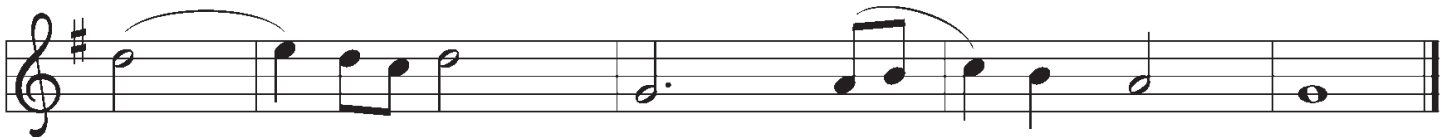

for the Lord has spoken.

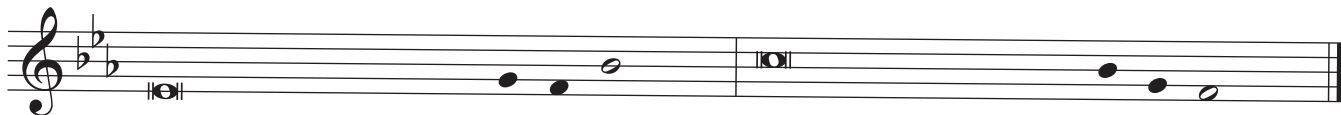
